# 1. Inauguration of Phase II Plantation Programme at Panawadi Village, Taluka Purandar, Dist. Pune on 22<sup>nd</sup> June, 2021

Science and Technology Park, Pune with an aim of socio-economic and ecological development of Panawadi village and convert it into a model replicable sustainable village with highest United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, has taken a mission of planting 50,000 fruit trees within three years as an effort to enhance ecology as well as economy and nutrition status of the Panawadi population.

Since last year, Scitech Park has already completed plantation of around 5000 saplings which were a mix of fruit trees, medicinal plants as well as varieties which are indigenous to the Western Ghats.

The Phase II plantation programme was inaugurated on Tuesday, 22nd June, 2021 at Pathar Plantation site, Vadachi Wadi, village Panawadi, Tq. Purandar, Dist. Pune. This was to initiate the plantation programme by planting the first batch of 60 fruit trees consisting of Guavas, Mangoes, Custard Apple, Black Plum, Jack Fruit and Indian Gooseberry. The varieties of saplings planted are as per the request made by the villagers and a total of 500 such saplings were planted under this Phase II plantation programme at Panawadi.

The project has been jointly supported by OneLess, Finolex Industries Ltd.Pune, and its CSR partner Mukul Madhav Foundation, Pune. In recent years, cultivation of medicinal plants has started gaining momentum. Medicinal plants are not only a major resource base for the traditional medicine & herbal industry but they also provide livelihood and health security to a large segment of Indian population. Considering the geography, water and land availability, Panawadi village has a huge potential for sustainable medicinal plantations across its four wadis.

The farmers are very keen to support medicinal plantations and they have agreed to plant around 5000 medicinal plants across the available land and create a unique medicinal plantation belt within the village in coming years. This initiative under Scitech Park's mission of 50,000 tree plantation in the village will ultimately stimulate rural economy, create jobs and help maintain critical ecosystem of the place and strengthen climate resilience of the rural poor.
